



MINI-GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS

Midwest AARST offers a limited number of mini-grants each year as the treasury allows in the amount of \$500 - \$1000 at the Midwest Spring Conference and the Annual International Radon Symposium for the purpose of reducing radioactive radon exposure. A Mini-Grant Selection Committee is comprised of several of the Midwest Board members whose duty it is to make the grantee selection.

Rules and Procedures:

1. The deadline for submitting application for a mini-grant for the Midwest Spring Conference is January 31, of that year. The deadline for submitting an application for a Midwest Chapter mini-grant at the International Radon Symposium is June 31, of that year.
2. A cover letter describing the project, it's purpose, and it's anticipated outcome must be submitted with the application form below along with the Project Statement and Project Description:
